Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 405 would update the Nebraska Energy Code by adopting the 2018 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC).

LB 405 would also require that any county, city, or village which amends or modifies its local building or construction code to delete provisions of the Nebraska Energy Code notify the State Energy Office of such amendment or modification within thirty days.
