Starting on or before June 30, 2021, LB1080 proposes that all public, private, denominational, and parochial schools in Nebraska establish policies and procedures that prohibit grooming, any type of sexual contact/communication, or relationships between students and former students with any school employee or student teachers/interns. Violations of this bill may result in employee or student teacher/intern being reported to the Nebraska Department of Education, Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, law enforcement, or all of the above.

There is no fiscal impact for the Nebraska Department of Education but there may be some undetermined expenditures for the school districts if an incident that falls under this bill occurs.

No additional cost to the Dept. of Education as the duties are almost entirely placed on public and private schools for policy adoption and notice provision. Reporting to this Department is referenced in the bill. Such reports already are provided for in the law and regulations in the form of filing of complaints for violations of certificate holders' standards of professional responsibility. Other reports concerning alleged "grooming" by non-certificated school employees are only required to be filed with this Department, and there would not appear to be any fiscal impact beyond negligible to maintain such reports.
