**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

In 2017 legislation was passed (LB 624) that allowed the county assessor and register of deeds to withhold from the public the residential address of a law enforcement officer if requested by application using a form prescribed by the county assessor. LB 152 would extend this ability to have residential addresses withheld to members of the Nebraska National Guard who participate with state, county, or local government in a law enforcement function prescribed by that government.

As a process to comply with the provisions of LB 624 in regards to law enforcement officers is already in place there should be little to no cost to modify the existing process to be inclusive of National Guard members.
