**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB 269, as amended, includes the provisions of LB 579. These provisions enable individuals who are guilty of driving under the influence of alcoholic liquor or drugs and who cause serious bodily injury to another person or an unborn child of a pregnant woman to be issued an ignition interlock permit. The fee for an ignition interlock permit is \$45. The fee is deposited in the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Cash Fund (\$5) and the DMV Ignition Interlock Fund (\$40).

The number of additional ignition interlock permits that will be issued pursuant to the bill is unknown. The DMV projects there will be a minimal number of permits issued each year per the bill, so any revenue increase will be small.
