Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB534 provides that once every two years, each public postsecondary educational institution is to administer a voluntary, anomymous sexual assault campus climate survey to its students.

The bill would require each public postsecondary education institution to:

- Develop a survey and establish procedures for administration of the survey.
- On or before September 1, 2019 and September 1 of each odd-numbered year thereafter, electronically submit a report to the Legislature that includes the results of the sexual assault campus climate survey.
- On or before January 1, 2020, develop a program for training for all individuals involved in implementing student grievance procedures relating to sexual assaults or sexual misconduct policy violations.

The Nebraska State College System indicates that the State Colleges already meet the requirements of the sexual assault climate survey and that other requirements of LB534 can be met with minimal costs.

The Nebraska Community College Association indicates the provisions of LB534 represents minimal fiscal impact to the five community college areas representing membership of the association.

Metropolitan Community College Area estimates minimal (\$5,000) annual costs associated with provisions of LB534.

The University of Nebraska indicates that based upon available information, it estimates costs of a related survey by campus would approximate \$400,000 to develop and establish procedures for administration of the survey and estimates ongoing costs of \$25,000 to revise the sexual assault campus climate survey every other year.

Based on information available, we estimate an effective survey, with results by campus, would cost about \$400,000. We estimate additional time and costs to revise the survey each off year. Our update assumes the survey dates will be revised to September of 2020 (vs. 2019 in the bill). If not, the alternating year would move into FY 22. We continue to have concerns with the reporting of "The outcome of each investigation into sexual misconduct" and "Disciplinary actions taken by the institution" and whether it will violate FERPA for students, bargaining agreements for employees and a variety of other laws and regulations. With some added clarity, such as AM 686, we hope a more generalized reporting might provide easier compliance. We believe the training is already being accomplished. AM 686 would eliminates the requirement for a survey and thus the costs associated with this fiscal note.
