Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 697 pertains to license plates for veterans and the military. The bill eliminates the payment of any plate fees for individuals who have Pearl Harbor, Gold Star Family, Military Honor, Prisoner of War, Disabled American Veteran or Purple Heart license plates. Current law caps the license plate fee at \$3.50 per plate. Plates are currently issued for \$3.30 per plate, which is the cost of a generic license plate. Revenue from plate fees is deposited in the Highway Trust Fund. If the manufacturing cost of the plates exceeds the amount charged for the plates, the difference is made up from the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund.

The bill also eliminates a \$5 initial and renewal fee for numeric Gold Star Family plates and Military Honor plates and a \$40 initial and renewal fee for personalized Gold Star Family and Military Honor plates. The \$5 fee for the numeric plates is deposited into the Nebraska Veteran Cemetery System Operation Fund (NVCSOF) and the \$40 message plate fee is remitted to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) Cash Fund (25%) and the NVCSOF (75%).

Revenues: The bill reduces revenue for the Highway Trust Fund (HTF), the DMV Cash Fund and the NVCSOF. DMV estimates the elimination of the \$5 annual fee for numeric Military Honor plates and Gold Star Family plates and the \$40 fee for personalized message plates will decrease annual revenue received by the DMV Cash Fund by \$65,000 and the NVCSOF by \$239,000.

There will also be a loss in revenue for the Highway Trust Fund. Currently, the cost to the HTF for of a set of these veterans and military plates is \$7.56 per set (\$3.78 per plate). The individual purchasing the plates pays \$6.60 (\$3.30 per plate). The difference of \$.96 is absorbed by the NVCSOF since the manufacturing cost exceeds the amount charged. The Department of Transportation estimates the annual loss to the HTF for the number of plates currently issued is about \$9,407 in FY20 and \$14,111 in FY21.

In addition, it is assumed there will be an increase in the number of veterans and military plates issued in the future since there will no longer be any additional charges for numeric or personalized message plates. The increase in number is unknown but could be fairly significant. Any increase in the number of plates issued will further decrease revenue for the HTF, DMV Cash Fund and NVCSPOF.

Expenditures: The revenue received from fees for Military Honor Plates and Gold Star Family Plates which is deposited in the NVCSOF is used to operate the Veterans' Cemetery in Alliance. The loss in revenue will mean that general funds will be required in lieu of cash funds to operate the cemetery in the future. It appears the existing cash fund balance of the NVCSOF will be sufficient to fund cemetery operations as requested by the agency in FY2019-20. However, in FY2020-21, based on the preliminary decisions of the Appropriations Committee, the bill will result in the need for about \$80,000 of general funds to continue cemetery operations. In the following biennium, approximately \$239,000 of general funds will be needed each fiscal year to operate the cemetery in Alliance.
