- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to health care; to amend section 68-901, 1 2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, as amended by section 1, 3 Initiative Law 2018, No. 427; to prohibit inclusion of long-term 4 services and supports under the medicaid managed care program as prescribed; to provide notification duties for the Department of 5 Health and Human Services and Department of Insurance prior to 6 7 submitting certain state waiver requests; to harmonize provisions; 8 and to repeal the original section.
- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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- 1 Section 1. Section 68-901, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, as
- 2 amended by section 1, Initiative Law 2018, No. 427, is amended to read:
- 3 68-901 Sections 68-901 to 68-991, and section 2 of this act, and
- 4 section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Medical
- 5 Assistance Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. Until July 1, 2021, the department shall not add long-term
- 7 care services and supports to the medicaid managed care program. For
- 8 purposes of this section, long-term care services and supports includes
- 9 services of a skilled nursing facility, a nursing facility, and an
- 10 assisted-living facility and home and community-based services.
- 11 Sec. 3. <u>The Department of Health and Human Services shall notify</u>
- 12 the chairperson and members of the Health and Human Services Committee of
- 13 the Legislature prior to submitting any request or application to the
- 14 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services of the United States
- 15 <u>Department of Health and Human Services for a demonstration project</u>
- 16 waiver under section 1115 of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 1315.
- 17 Such notification shall be made electronically and shall include a copy
- 18 of any documentation presented to the public related to the waiver. The
- 19 Health and Human Services Committee of the Legislature shall hold a
- 20 public hearing on such waiver application during the period for public
- 21 <u>comment required under 42 C.F.R. 431.408.</u>
- 22 Sec. 4. The Department of Insurance shall notify the chairperson
- 23 and members of the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee of the
- 24 <u>Legislature prior to submitting any request or application to the Centers</u>
- 25 for Medicare and Medicaid Services of the United States Department of
- 26 Health and Human Services for a state innovation waiver under section
- 27 <u>1332 of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. Such</u>
- 28 notification shall be made electronically and shall include a copy of the
- 29 <u>application for the federal waiver. The Banking, Commerce and Insurance</u>
- 30 <u>Committee of the Legislature shall hold a public hearing on such waiver</u>
- 31 application.
