2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2020, the following
4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

6 To amend Article I, section 2:

7 I-2 There shall be neither slavery nor involuntary servitude in this
8 state, ~~otherwise than for punishment of crime, whereof the party shall~~
9 ~~have been duly convicted.~~

10 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
11 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
12 section 1, with the following ballot language:

13 A constitutional amendment to eliminate slavery or involuntary
14 servitude as a punishment for crime.
