Committee: Education

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to education; to require hotline phone numbers
- 2 on student identification cards for middle school, high school, and
- 3 postsecondary students as prescribed; and to harmonize provisions.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Beginning with the 2021-22 school year, each school
2 board shall require that the phone number for a national suicide
3 prevention hotline, a local suicide prevention hotline, or a crisis text
4 line is printed on each new student identification card issued to a
5 student enrolled in a middle school grade or a high school grade, as
6 defined by such school board, in a school under the authority of such
7 school board. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the
8 issuance of student identification cards to students in any school.

9 Sec. 2. Beginning with the 2021-22 academic year, each public
10 postsecondary institution authorized to operate in this state shall
11 require that the phone number for a national suicide prevention hotline,
12 a local suicide prevention hotline, or a crisis text line is printed on
13 each new student identification card issued to a student enrolled in such
14 public postsecondary institution. Nothing in this section shall be
15 construed to require the issuance of student identification cards to
16 students in any postsecondary institution.
