- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Legislature; to amend section 32-508,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the number of
- 3 legislative districts; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 32-508, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 32-508 Until the Legislature convenes in January 2023, the The
4 State of Nebraska is divided into forty-nine legislative districts as
5 provided and described in sections 50-1153 and 50-1154. Beginning with
6 the members nominated and elected to take office in January 2023, the
7 State of Nebraska is divided into fifty legislative districts. The
8 members of the Legislature from the even-numbered districts shall be
9 elected for terms of four years at the statewide general election in 1994
10 and each four years thereafter. The members of the Legislature from the
11 odd-numbered districts shall be elected for terms of four years at the
12 statewide general election in 1996 and each four years thereafter.
13 Candidates for the Legislature shall meet the qualifications found in
14 Article III, sections 8 and 9, of the Constitution of Nebraska. The
15 members of the Legislature shall be elected on the nonpartisan ballot.

16 Sec. 2. Original section 32-508, Reissue Revised Statutes of
17 Nebraska, is repealed.
