LEGISLATIVE BILL 118

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county records; to provide for withholding
- 2 the residential address of a physician or an osteopathic physician
- 3 from the public; and to provide an operative date.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Unless requested by a member of the public in writing,
2 the county assessor and register of deeds shall withhold from the public
3 the residential address of a physician or an osteopathic physician
4 licensed under the Medicine and Surgery Practice Act who applies to the
5 county assessor in the county of his or her residence to have such
6 address withheld. The application shall be on a form prescribed by the
7 county assessor and shall include the name, address, and medical license
8 number of the physician or osteopathic physician and the parcel
9 identification number for his or her residential address. The county
10 assessor shall notify the register of deeds regarding the receipt of a
11 complete application. The county assessor and the register of deeds shall
12 withhold the address of a physician or an osteopathic physician who
13 complies with this section for five years after receipt of a complete
14 application. The physician or osteopathic physician may renew his or her
15 application every five years upon submission of an updated application. A
16 change of address requires a new application.

17 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.
