- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to postsecondary education; to amend section
- 2 85-502.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to change
- 3 requirements for veterans and their spouses and dependents and other
- 4 eligible persons to qualify as resident students as prescribed; and
- 5 to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 85-502.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2018, is amended to read:

3 85-502.01 (1) A person who enrolls in a public college or university
4 in this state and who is (a) a veteran as defined in Title 38 of the
5 United States Code and was discharged or released from a period of not
6 fewer than ninety days of service in the active military, naval, or air
7 service less than three years before the date of initial enrollment, (b)
8 a spouse or dependent of such a veteran, (c) ~~or~~ an eligible recipient
9 entitled to educational assistance as provided in 38 U.S.C. 3319 while
10 the transferor is on active duty in the uniformed services or as provided
11 in 38 U.S.C. 3311(b)(9), as such sections existed on March January 1,
12 2019 2017, or (d) a recipient of vocational rehabilitation program
13 services as provided in 38 U.S.C. 3100 et seq., as such section existed
14 on March 1, 2019, shall be considered a resident student notwithstanding
15 the provisions of section 85-502 if the person is ~~(a)~~ registered to vote
16 in Nebraska and ~~(b)~~ demonstrates objective evidence of intent to be a
17 resident of Nebraska, except that a ~~-(2)-~~ A person who is otherwise
18 ~~described in subsection (1) of this section and is~~ under eighteen years
19 of age is not required to register to vote in Nebraska ~~comply with~~
20 ~~subdivision (1)(a) of this section.~~

21 (2) (3) For purposes of this section, objective evidence of intent
22 to be a resident of Nebraska includes either a Nebraska driver's license
23 or state identification card or a Nebraska motor vehicle registration.
