- 5 nonlicensed persons as prescribed; and to repeal the original

- 1 Section 1. Section 53-168.06, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 2 Supplement, 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 53-168.06 No person shall manufacture, bottle, blend, sell, barter,
- 4 transport, deliver, furnish, or possess any alcoholic liquor for beverage
- 5 purposes except as specifically provided in the Nebraska Liquor Control
- 6 Act. Nothing in the act shall prevent:
- 7 (1) The the possession of alcoholic liquor legally obtained as
- 8 provided in the act for the personal use of the possessor and his or her
- 9 family and guests;
- 10 (2) The the making, transport, and delivery of wine, cider, beer,
- 11 <u>mead, perry,</u> or other alcoholic liquor by a person from fruits,
- 12 vegetables, <u>honey</u>, or grains, or the product thereof, by simple
- 13 fermentation and without distillation, (a) if made solely for the use of
- 14 the maker and his or her family and guests_if such alcoholic liquor is
- 15 <u>not sold or offered for sale, or (b) if made without a permit for an</u>
- 16 <u>exhibition</u>, <u>festival</u>, <u>or tasting competition</u>, <u>including exhibitions</u>,
- 17 <u>festivals, or tasting competitions that are for nonprofit organizations</u>
- 18 <u>such as fundraising events, legally conducted under the act, if such</u>
- 19 <u>alcoholic liquor is not sold or offered for sale. Alcoholic liquor served</u>
- 20 pursuant to this subdivision (b) shall clearly be identified as alcoholic
- 21 <u>liquor that was manufactured under an exception to the rules and</u>
- 22 regulations of the commission by signage, and the location of the
- 23 <u>manufacturer shall be available upon request. Free or reduced admission</u>
- 24 to the exhibition, festival, or tasting competition shall not be
- 25 considered a sale of the alcoholic liquor;
- 26 (3) Any any duly licensed practicing physician or dentist from
- 27 possessing or using alcoholic liquor in the strict practice of his or her
- 28 profession, any hospital or other institution caring for the sick and
- 29 diseased persons from possessing and using alcoholic liquor for the
- 30 treatment of bona fide patients of such hospital or other institution, or
- 31 any drug store employing a licensed pharmacist from possessing or using

1 alcoholic liquor in the compounding of prescriptions of licensed

- 2 physicians;
- 3 (4) The the possession and dispensation of alcoholic liquor by an
- 4 authorized representative of any religion on the premises of a place of
- 5 worship, for the purpose of conducting any bona fide religious rite,
- 6 ritual, or ceremony;
- 7 (5) Persons persons who are sixteen years old or older from carrying
- 8 alcoholic liquor from licensed establishments when they are accompanied
- 9 by a person not a minor;
- 10 (6) Persons persons who are sixteen years old or older from handling
- 11 alcoholic liquor containers and alcoholic liquor in the course of their
- 12 employment;
- 13 (7) <u>Persons</u> persons who are sixteen years old or older from removing
- 14 and disposing of alcoholic liquor containers for the convenience of the
- 15 employer and customers in the course of their employment;
- 16 (8) Persons persons who are sixteen years old or older from
- 17 completing a transaction for the sale of alcoholic liquor in the course
- 18 of their employment if they are not handling or serving alcoholic liquor;
- 19 or
- 20 (9) Persons persons who are nineteen years old or older from serving
- 21 or selling alcoholic liquor in the course of their employment.
