6	Sec. 2. (1) For purposes of this section, scleral tattooing means
7	the practice of using needles, scalpels, or other related equipment to
8	produce an indelible mark or figure on the human eye by scarring or
9	inserting a pigment on, in, or under:
10	<u>(a) The fornix conjunctiva;</u>
11	<u>(b) The bulbar conjunctiva;</u>
12	<u>(c) The ocular conjunctiva; or</u>
13	<u>(d) Another ocular surface.</u>
14	<u>(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, a person</u>
15	shall not perform or offer to perform scleral tattooing on another
16	person.
17	<u>(3) This section does not apply to an act of a health care</u>
18	professional when the act is performed in the scope of the health care
19	professional's practice.
20	(4) A person who violates this section is subject to a civil penalty
21	not to exceed ten thousand dollars for each violation. The department
22	shall remit the civil penalty to the State Treasurer for distribution in
23	accordance with Article VII, section 5, of the Constitution of Nebraska.
