**LEGISLATIVE BILL 699**

Introduced by Bostelman, 23.

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Registration Act; to
- 2 amend section 60-378, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018;
- 3 to change provisions relating to transporter plates; and to repeal
- 4 the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-378, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,  
2 2018, is amended to read:

3 60-378 (1) Any transporter doing business in this state may, in lieu  
4 of registering each motor vehicle or trailer which such transporter is  
5 transporting, upon payment of a fee of ten dollars, apply to the  
6 department for a transporter's certificate and one transporter license  
7 plate. Additional pairs of transporter certificates and transporter  
8 license plates may be procured for a fee of ten dollars each. Transporter  
9 license plates shall be displayed (a) upon the motor vehicle or trailer  
10 being transported or (b) upon a properly registered truck or truck-  
11 tractor which is a work or service vehicle in the process of towing a  
12 trailer which is itself being delivered by the transporter, and such  
13 registered truck or truck-tractor shall also display a transporter plate  
14 upon the front thereof. The applicant for a transporter plate shall keep  
15 for three ~~six~~ years a record of each motor vehicle or trailer transported  
16 by him or her under this section, and such record shall be available to  
17 the department for inspection. Each applicant shall file with the  
18 department proof of his or her status as a bona fide transporter.

19 (2) Transporter license plates may be the same size as license  
20 plates issued for motorcycles other than autocycles, shall bear thereon a  
21 mark to distinguish them as transporter plates, and shall be serially  
22 numbered so as to distinguish them from each other. Such license plates  
23 may only be displayed upon the front of a driven motor vehicle of a  
24 lawful combination or upon the front of a motor vehicle driven singly or  
25 upon the rear of a trailer being towed.
