- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to require coverage for
- 2 prescription epinephrine autoinjectors for persons eighteen years of
- 3 age or younger; and to provide a duty for the Revisor of Statutes.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1.   (1) Beginning January 1, 2021, and notwithstanding  
2 section 44-3,131, (a) any individual or group sickness and accident  
3 insurance policy or subscriber contract delivered, issued for delivery,  
4 or renewed in this state and any hospital, medical, or surgical expense-  
5 incurred policy, except for policies that provide coverage for a  
6 specified disease or other limited-benefit coverage, and (b) any self-  
7 funded employee benefit plan to the extent not preempted by federal law,  
8 shall provide coverage for a prescription epinephrine autoinjector for  
9 persons eighteen years of age or younger.

10           (2) For purposes of this section, epinephrine autoinjector means a  
11 medical device approved by the federal Food and Drug Administration for  
12 the administration of epinephrine that contains a pre-measured dose of  
13 epinephrine.

14           Sec. 2. The Revisor of Statutes shall assign section 1 of this act  
15 to Chapter 44, article 7.
