- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2020, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To amend Article VI, section 2:
- 7 VI-2 No person shall be qualified to vote who is non compos mentis,
- 8 or who has been convicted of treason or felony under the laws of the
- 9 state or of the United States, unless restored to civil rights.
- 10 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 11 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 12 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 13 A constitutional amendment to remove felony convictions other than
- 14 treason from being a disqualification for voting.
