LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 370

Introduced by Urban Affairs Committee: Wayne, 13, Chairperson; Arch, 14;
Briese, 41; Crawford, 45; Hansen, M., 26; Hunt, 8; Lowe, 37.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this interim study is to examine the statutes governing all classes of municipalities in Chapter 18 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes. The goal of the study shall be to update and modernize statutes through the elimination of obsolete, antiquated, and duplicate statutory language.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

1. That the Urban Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
