Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB755

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB755 amends 38-10,121, 71-202.01, and 71-224 in order to create provisions for home barber services. This bill would allow a barbershop to have their licensed barbers perform home barber services if they obtain a home barber services permit.

A home barber permit applies to customers who are immobilized due to infirmities that include aging, conditions that leave them temporarily incapacitated, people with mental health challenges such as agoraphobia or anxiety, as well as sole caregivers who do not have the option to leave for basic self-care tasks like a haircut.

The barbershop using home services must post a list of their barbers who are offering these services and the home barber license will be reviewed when the barber shop's standard license is reviewed.

LB755 also amends 38-10,160 to change the circumstances where home nail tech services are allowed from "emergency" to "emergency or persistent."
