Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 758 honors the artists who created the Nebraska State Capitol by naming the courtyards in their names as follows:

- The northeast courtyard is named the Bertram Goodhue courtyard recognizing his design for the building.
- The southeast courtyard is named the Hartley Burr Alexander courtyard recognizing his development of original inscriptions and themes for decoration of the building.
- The southwest courtyard is named the Hildreth Meière courtyard recognizing her designs for mosaics appearing throughout the building.
- The northwest courtyard is named the Lee Lawrie courtyard recognizing his stone carvings and the iconic Sower atop the building.
