

LEGISLATIVE BILL 414

Approved by the Governor May 29, 2019

Introduced by Brandt, 32; Erdman, 47.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to county highway superintendents; to amend section 39-1508, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change duties as prescribed; to eliminate an annual report requirement; to repeal the original section; and to outright repeal section 39-1512, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 39-1508, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

39-1508 It shall be the duty of the county highway superintendent to:

(1) ~~Annually submit~~ Submit to the county board ~~no later than February 1 of each year a proposed annual program, to be known as the county road annual program, proposing a proposed schedule of construction, repair, maintenance, and supervision of county roads and bridges in conjunction with sections 39-2115, 39-2119, and 39-2120, including federal-aid secondary road projects and a list of equipment and material purchases to be undertaken and carried out by the county within the limits of the estimated funds of the county during the next twelve months;~~

(2) ~~Annually file~~ File with the county clerk ~~no later than February 1 of each year~~ a revised and current map of the county roads clearly distinguishing the primary and secondary roads, ~~and~~ indicating the past year's improvements thereon, ~~and showing the number of miles of roads established during the year and the location thereof;~~ and

(3) Undertake the projects contained in subdivision (1) of this section ~~the county road annual program in the order therein stated,~~ and when requested by the county board report the projects completed, the projects in construction, ~~the~~ and equipment and material purchased, the amounts expended upon roads and bridges, ~~and the sum remaining to be expended, except~~ ; ~~Provided, that in case of an emergency deviations from the adopted program may be authorized by the unanimous vote of the county board~~ in case of an emergency.

Sec. 2. Original section 39-1508, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.

Sec. 3. The following section is outright repealed: Section 39-1512, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
