Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB191 amends the Irrigation District Act at Section 46-102 to allow otherwise qualified non-resident landowners or leaseholders within an Irrigation district to be qualified as an elector, if (1) the geographical boundaries of the entire district consist of fewer than two thousand (2,000) total acres; (2) the irrigation district borders another state; and 3) more than one-half of the landowners or leaseholders of land within the district reside outside of Nebraska. LB191 was amended into LB507.
