# Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would amend section 44-793 to provide that a health insurance plan that covers treatment of mental health conditions (1) shall not establish a rate, term, or condition that places a greater financial burden on an insured for accessing treatment for a mental health condition using telehealth or telemonitoring services, and (2) shall provide, at a minimum, a reimbursement rate for accessing treatment for a mental health condition using telehealth condition using telehealth or telemonitoring services that is the same as the rate for a comparable treatment provided or supervised in person.

# **Explanation of amendments:**

The committee amendments would provide that the bill applies to accessing treatment for a mental health condition using "telehealth" services rather than telehealth and "telemonitoring" services.
