Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill changes the requirements for obtaining an occupational license as a voice stress analysis examiner. It replaces the requirement for a baccalaureate degree with a requirement that the applicant be a certified law enforcement officer. It removes the one-year internship requirement.

The bill also includes a number of revisor changes, including replacement of statute range citations with citations to the name of the act.
