Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would amend section 44-7508 (file and use), section 44-7509 (individual risk premium increase or decrease), and section 44-7510 (prior approval) to provide that a rate filing may not discriminate between risks and a rate adjustment or a risk classification may not be based solely upon the fact that the insured is deployed in the military outside of the United States, United States territories, and the District of Columbia for a period of six months or greater.
