This bill limits the fees collected by the counties and shifts the authority for collection of those fees to problem-solving courts. The bill also authorizes problem-solving courts to charge participants for the cost for drug and alcohol tests, psychological evaluations, offender assessment screens and electronic monitoring.

Counties would have a reduction in fees. The impact would vary by county. Charging participants of problem-solving courts is discretionary on the part of the judges. An estimate of revenue is not available at this time.
