LB154 makes several changes to and amends §79-760 by adding:

On or before August 1, 2022, the State Board of Education will implement a statewide system for tracking individual student discipline, using the student identifier system of the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE), that can be aggregated to track student discipline by type of discipline and demographic characteristics, including, but not limited to, race, poverty, high mobility, attendance, disability, and limited English proficiency. Each school district will submit a report, by individual student, any:

- An act resulting in an in-school suspension, a short-term suspension, a long-term suspension, a one-semester expulsion, a
  two-semester expulsion, an assignment to an alternative school or alternative-learning program, the use of physical contact
  with such student, or the restraint or seclusion of such student
- An offense constituting grounds for a long-term suspension, an expulsion, or a mandatory reassignment pursuant to §79-267, regardless of consequences assigned
- An act resulting in law enforcement involvement, including any incident reported to law enforcement or to an on-site school resource officer, and any school-related citation or arrest

The system for tracking individual student discipline may also be used to record other disciplinary incidents. Each school will designate at least one discipline data coordinator for the purposes of gathering and reporting the discipline data as required by LB154.

No Fiscal Impact to the state but there may be some impact to the school district for software and staffing to meet the requirements above.
