Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 344 amends the One-Call Notification System Act. As amended by AM1880, enforcement of the One-Call Notification System Act is shifted from the Attorney General to the State Fire Marshal. Under the bill's provisions, the State Fire Marshal is responsible for investigating complaints and making determinations regarding violations of the Act.

The State Fire Marshal estimates the need for 2 FTEs, IT costs related to databases, form development, and storage costs to administer the bill's provisions. The total estimated costs are \$291,240 in fiscal year 2022-23 and \$218,642 beginning in fiscal year 2023-24. \$50,000 of this total funding will come from Federal Funds.

There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.

## **Explanation of Estimate:**

AM1880 to LB 344 would remove enforcement authority of the One Call Act from the Attorney General and transfer it to the State Fire Marshal Agency. AM1880 requires the State Fire Marshal Agency to receive and processes complaint forms regarding possible violations of the One Call System requirements. The Agency will investigate complaints and make determinations regarding violations and issue civil penalty amounts. All Agency decisions will be subject to appeal under the Administrative Procedures Act.

In FY 22-23 the Agency will incur IT costs related to databases, forms development, and storage for an estimated cost of \$10,000. An administrative appeals hearing officer and hearing transcription services will be obtained for an approximate cost of \$103,500 in FY 22-23; in FY 23-24 the cost for these services is projected at \$51,750 . Additional operating and managerial costs, for items such as office equipment, vehicles, uniforms, and other various costs for FY 22-23 are approximately \$30,820; in FY23-24 \$16,004. There will also be travel expenses of \$14,693 in both fiscal years The Agency will require additional staffing of one deputy position and one administrative position; salary and benefit costs for FY22-23 of approximately \$132,227 and in FY23-24 \$136,195. Total costs for FY22-23 will be \$291,240—there will be \$50,000 in Federal Funds and \$241,240 general funds. Total costs for FY23-24 will be \$218,642 —there will be \$50,000 in Federal Funds and \$168,642 in General Funds.
