Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would adopt the Municipal Police Oversight Act.

This bill appears to apply only to Omaha and Lincoln, although other cities could come under the bill's provisions if they adopt home rule charter.

On or before January 1, 2022, each city shall create a citizen police oversight board. The bill lists the oversight boards duties.

A city shall provide its oversight board with sufficient funding and resources to adequately perform its duties. Each investigation carried out under the authority of the oversight board shall be conducted independently of the police department of such city.

The city of Omaha estimates annual costs of \$313,761 for the following items: one investigator and one clerical staff in Internal Affairs, and two Oversight Board investigators.

The city of Lincoln estimates costs of \$150,000 for the following items: salary and benefits for an employee, administration costs, training, and supplies. Additional costs could include office space, transportation, and other operating costs.

Because this bill imposes additional duties on certain cities and requires funding, it is not unreasonable to estimate that these cities would incur additional costs. At this time, there is no basis to disagree with the estimated costs of Omaha or Lincoln.
