LB 581 exempts persons 21 years of age or older who is operating, or is a passenger on, a motorcycle or moped from wearing a protective helmet if the individual has been certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation basic motorcycle rider course or other substantially similar motorcycle rider course. A requirement for motorcycle and moped operators to wear eye protection is also placed in statute.

The DOT has provided a fiscal note indicating replacement of signs at border crossings would cost an estimated \$23,000 can be absorbed within their existing appropriation.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 581 changes helmet provisions and requires eye protection. If passed, this would allow a person who is at least twenty-one years of age and has been certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation basic motorcycle rider course or other substantially similar motorcycle rider course to be exempt from wearing a protective helmet while operating or as a passenger on a motorcycle or moped. In addition, a person shall not operate a motorcycle or moped on any highway in the state unless such person and passengers have eye protection.

If this bill passes, the Department of Transportation would need to modify signs at the state border crossings. A replacement of the current signs is estimated at \$23,000. These additional expenditures can be accommodated within existing appropriation.
