LB659 establishes the Outdoor Recreation and Education Study Committee of the Legislature as a special legislative committee to to identify short-term and long-term statewide goals to improve outdoor recreation and education in the state and develop recommendations for the prioritization of policies, programs, projects, and activities to be funded to achieve those goals.

Expenses for hearings and committee member expenses would be no additional costs than what would otherwise occur if the activities were conducted under an existing standing committee or interim study. The bill directs the Director of Research to assign a staff member to provide assistance to the committee along with other existing legislative staff. There could possibly be additional costs if existing staff cannot be reallocated depending on the depth of the study and amount of workload.
