**Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.**

LB669 creates the Veteran Promise Act and would require post-secondary institutions in Nebraska to automatically accept any eligible military student or any veteran student to enroll as an undergraduate student in courses and programs. It will require that the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education create an application for the Veteran Promise Act and submit an annual report to the Legislature. Based on the bill's language, the Act would apply to a small number of applicants since, among other requirements, an eligible student must have signed enlistment papers prior to December 31, 2022, and graduated from a Nebraska high school during calendar year 2022. No fiscal impact to the state is expected, based on the attached statements from three of Nebraska's post-secondary agencies.
