The Act's purpose is to provide for the efficient procurement of goods and services by governmental units and promote economical, nondiscriminatory and efficient administration and completion of construction projects.

Section 3 provides definitions for the Act.

Section 4 requires (unless prohibited by federal law) a governmental unit to ensure that any requests for proposals or bid specifications for a public contract or the procurement procedures for a public contract contain certain information.

Sections 5 through 7 prohibit governmental units from certain actions under the Government Neutrality in Contracting Act.

The governmental units providing responses for fiscal impact all report that the bill's provisions will have no fiscal impact.
