LEGISLATIVE BILL 1078

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to state findings; to define
- terms; and to prohibit possession of personal electronic devices by
- 3 students in public schools as prescribed.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature finds that unrestricted use of
- 2 personal electronic devices by students at elementary and secondary
- 3 schools during the school day interferes with the educational mission of
- 4 the schools, lowers student performance, and promotes cyberbullying.
- 5 (2) For purposes of this section:
- 6 (a) Accessory means any electronic device that is not the property
- 7 of the school district and that can be connected, whether through a wired
- 8 connection or wirelessly, to a personal electronic device;
- 9 (b)(i) Personal electronic device means a device that is not the
- 10 property of the school district and that:
- 11 (A) Can be used to access the Internet, and includes, but is not
- 12 limited to, a smart phone, tablet, or virtual reality device; or
- 13 <u>(B) Can be used to listen to audio recordings or watch video</u>
- 14 <u>recordings</u>.
- 15 (ii) Personal electronic device does not include a student-owned
- 16 laptop or other device approved for use in the classroom by the school;
- 17 (c) School means any elementary or secondary school operated by a
- 18 school district; and
- 19 <u>(d) Storage compartment means a storage container or a</u>
- 20 <u>compartmentalized portion of a storage container which:</u>
- 21 (i) Holds only the personal electronic device or accessory of a
- 22 single student;
- 23 (ii) Is clear or translucent; and
- 24 (iii) Separates each student's property so as to provide for easy
- 25 identification and to maintain privacy.
- 26 (3) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section:
- 27 (a) Upon entering a classroom, a student shall place any personal
- 28 electronic device and accessory into a storage compartment. While in the
- 29 storage compartment, the personal electronic device and accessory shall
- 30 be turned off, placed on do not disturb mode, or otherwise configured to
- 31 not make noise, vibrate, or flash lights; and

1 (b) While in a classroom, a student shall not possess or use such

- 2 <u>personal electronic device or accessory.</u>
- 3 (4) A student may possess or use a personal electronic device and
- 4 accessory in a classroom:
- 5 (a) In the case of an emergency or when the student reasonably
- 6 perceives an imminent threat of an emergency or harm to any person;
- 7 (b) When a teacher grants permission for purposes of assisting in
- 8 <u>educational classroom activities or assignments;</u>
- 9 (c) When the student has a note from a health care provider stating
- 10 that possession or use is necessary for the student's health or well-
- 11 being; or
- 12 <u>(d) With written permission from a principal, the principal's</u>
- 13 <u>designee</u>, or a school counselor.
- 14 (5) Enforcement of this section shall be the prerogative of the
- 15 school district and school.
