**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 210 requires school boards to establish policies and procedures to allow students from schools which elect not to meet approval and accreditation requirements (exempt home schools) to participate in extracurricular activities (as defined in section 79-2,126) to the same extent as public school students. Exempt home schools shall set standards for satisfactory academic performance for such students to participate in such extracurricular activities and provide assurance of compliance with such academic standards. School board policies shall not require such students to enroll in courses offered for credit by the school district. Such students shall not be eligible for transportation, except to or from practices or events.
