The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB705 proposes two changes to the Barber Act, both of which are being put forward on behalf of the Board of Barber Examiners. The first change would eliminate a requirement for booth permits for barbers renting space in a barber shop. The second change would reduce the amount of in-school training for an assistant barber instructor from one year to nine months.
