All 3 features of construction shall be done in a manner that positively impacts inmate behavior, including, but not limited to, providing 4 5 appropriate correctional beds for both long-term and specialized housing, 6 proving design capacity for living spaces, common spaces, telehealth 7 stations dedicated for programming, and other relevant areas that allow 8 for substance abuse and mental health counseling and treatment, job 9 training, educational services, and any other programs or services that allow for humane care and housing and contribute to reduced recidivism 10 11 rates.
