19	the intent of the Legislature to continue such appropriations in future
20	years.

22	FY2023-24 \$1,000,000 General Funds to make a grant available for a
23	licensed residential child-care agency which provides outreach services
24	to homeless youth in a city of the primary class as of July 1, 2023, to
25	facilitate housing for pregnant and parenting homeless youth to be

located in a city of the primary class.

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Division of Children 1 2 and Family Services of the Department of Health and Human Services 3 provide a rate increase to child welfare providers under Program 354 by using unspent federal American Rescue Plan Act dollars reappropriated to 4 5 the department by the Legislature. Such rate increase should be equal to 6 an across-the-board increase of three percent in FY2023-24 and two 7 percent in FY2024-25. Further, it is the intent of the Legislature that such rate increases as described be acknowledged and accounted for by the 8 9 department as base rate increases for purposes of publishing rate schedules and for purposes of preparing budget requests in future 10 11 years. In addition, the following five services shall receive additional 12 increases in FY2023-24 and FY2024-25 to supplement the across-the-board increases in order to achieve a rate necessary to ensure sufficient 13 14 levels of service: Family Support; Parenting Time/Supervised Visits; 15 Travel Time and Distance; Intensive Family Preservation; and Intensive Family Reunification. 16
