- 21 circulator or circulators as provided in section 32-1303.
- 22 (2) If the filing clerk is the subject of a recall petition, the
- 23 signature verification process shall be conducted by two election
- 24 commissioners or county clerks appointed by the Secretary of State.
- 25 Mileage and expenses incurred by officials appointed pursuant to this
- 26 subsection shall be reimbursed by the political subdivision involved in
- 27 the recall.

- (3) Within fifteen business days after the filing of the petition, 1
- 2 the filing clerk shall ascertain whether or not the petition is signed by
- 3 the requisite number of registered voters. No new signatures may be added
- after the initial filing of the petition papers. Any person may remove 4
- 5 his or her name from a petition as provided in section 32-632. No
- 6 signatures may be removed unless the filing clerk receives an affidavit
- 7 signed by the person requesting his or her signature be removed before
- 8 the petitions are filed with the filing clerk for signature verification.

- (3) Any person who falsifies a letter submitted pursuant to section 25
- 26 32-632 or subsection (3) of section 32-1305 or who signs any name other
- 27 than his or her own to such letter shall be guilty of a Class I
- 28 misdemeanor.
