1 1. Insert the following new section:

14 (1) There is included in the appropriation to this program for
15 FY2023-24 \$4,107,500 General Funds for state aid for Nebraska Career
16 Scholarships, which shall only be used for such purpose. There is
17 included in the appropriation to this program for FY2024-25 \$4,240,000
18 General Funds for state aid for Nebraska Career Scholarships, which shall
19 only be used for such purpose.

20 (2) The unexpended General Fund appropriation balance existing on
21 June 30, 2023, from the appropriation for the Nebraska Career Scholarship
22 program is hereby reappropriated.

23 (3) There is included in the appropriation to this program for
24 FY2023-24 \$300,000 General Funds for state aid for the Rural Health
25 Opportunity Program and Public Health Early Admission Student Track
26 scholarships. There is included in the appropriation to this program for

1 FY2024-25 \$600,000 General Funds for state aid for the Rural Health
2 Opportunity Program and Public Health Early Admission Student Track
3 scholarships.

4 (4) It is the intent of the Legislature that upon the approval of
5 the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska State Colleges, the System Office
6 of the Nebraska State Colleges may divide and distribute the funds
7 appropriated to this program among Chadron State College, Peru State
8 College, Wayne State College, and the System Office of the Nebraska State
9 Colleges.

10 (5) It is the intent of the Legislature that Cash Fund revenue from
11 resident tuition, nonresident tuition, off-campus tuition, and fees
12 separately assessed shall be individually accounted for on the Nebraska
13 Information System.

14 (6) The Legislature reaffirms its intent to utilize the Nebraska
15 Educational Data System created by Laws 1978, LB 897, to support the
16 appropriations and oversight process for postsecondary education. It is
17 further the intent of the Legislature that all institutions provide the
18 data in the precise formats required by the Coordinating Commission for
19 Postsecondary Education.

20 (7) The Legislature reaffirms its commitment to long-range and
21 short-range computer planning by the Nebraska state colleges. It is the
22 intent of the Legislature that comprehensive computer plans of the
23 Nebraska state colleges be updated biennially and submitted to the
24 Legislative Fiscal Analyst, the Department of Administrative Services,
25 and the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education on or before
26 October 15 of each odd-numbered year. The plans required to be submitted
27 to the Legislative Fiscal Analyst by this section shall be submitted
28 electronically.

29 (8) The Department of Administrative Services shall monitor the
30 appropriations and expenditures of the Board of Trustees of the Nebraska
31 State Colleges, Agency No. 50-0, and the Nebraska State Colleges, Agency

1 Nos. 50-1, 50-3, and 50-4, according to NCHEMS-Program Classification
2 Structure, Second Edition. Expenditure authority shall be limited to
3 program appropriations.

4 (9) It is the intent of the Legislature for the Board of Trustees of
5 the Nebraska State Colleges to utilize a trust fund to record revenue and
6 expenses for the Corrections Workforce Development Pathway program at
7 Peru State College.

8 (10) There is included in the appropriation to this program for
9 FY2024-25 \$182,256 General Funds for tuition waivers provided pursuant to
10 section 85-2603.

11 2. On page 59, strike line 11, show as stricken, and insert "GENERAL
12 FUND 667,939,406 699,702,448"; and in line 13 strike "698,937,285" and
13 insert "699,702,448".

14 3. On page 64, after line 4 insert the following new subdivision:
15 "(15) There is included in the appropriation to this program for
16 FY2024-25 \$765,163 General Funds for tuition waivers provided pursuant to
17 section 85-2603.".

18 4. On page 103, line 25, after "173," insert "192,".

19 5. Renumber the remaining sections accordingly.
