Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1007 requires DHHS to submit a state plan amendment to authorize Medicaid eligibility for aged, blind and disabled individuals pursuant to the federal Social Security Act.

Sec. 1: No later than October 1, 2024, DHHS is required to submit a state plan amendment to the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) to authorize Medicaid eligibility pursuant to Section 1634 of the federal Social Security Act for aged, blind, and disabled program recipients who are eligible for the federal Supplemental Security Income Program.

Section 1634 of the federal Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1383c) allows the Commissioner of Social Security to enter into an agreement with any State to determine Medicaid eligibility for aged, blind, or disabled individuals.
