## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

## Bill Summary:

A school board or board of education is prohibited from granting access, meeting attendance, or signage privileges to a professional employees' organization without providing equal access to any other organization, and it is also restricted from naming or referring to any day or break in the school calendar using the name of a professional employees' organization.

Section-by-Section Summary:
Section 1.1 - DEFINITIONS
Professional Employees Organization
School Employee

## Section 1.2

A school board or board of education must provide equal access to the physical or electronic mailbox, attendance at meetings or events, and the creation and posting of signage or materials in schools to all professional employees' organizations requesting such access.

## Section 1.3

A school board or board of education is prohibited from naming or referring to any day or break in the school calendar using the name of any professional employee's organization.
