## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB1167 would amend § 29-1816 to require a person arrested without a warrant to be arraigned within fourteen days of arrest.

This section would also remove some outdated language.

## Explanation of amendments:

AM2829 would replace the original bill. AM2829 would amend section 29-404.02 to require a person arrested without a warrant to be brought before court for a first appearance within seven days. The appearance could be conducted by video. The person would have the right to appear in person, but would have to waive the seven day deadline if an in-person appearance is not reasonably practicable.
