## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

## Bill Summary:

Class I encompasses school districts with a population of fewer than one thousand five hundred inhabitants, maintaining both elementary and high school grades under the governance of a single school board.

Class II comprises school districts with a population ranging from one thousand five hundred to fewer than five thousand inhabitants, maintaining both elementary and high school grades under the governance of a single school board.

Class III encompasses school districts with a population between five thousand and fewer than two hundred thousand inhabitants, maintaining both elementary and high school grades under the governance of a single school board.

Other changes in the bill represent editing to include the newly proposed classes.
