Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 455 would establish a grant program to provide and distribute a monthly, nondigital publication to schools and home to facilitate development in reading ability and also to improve life-long learning skills.

Section 1

The Department of Education shall develop a grant program to facilitate development of student's reading skills.

Such grants shall be awarded to any statewide organization who represents a majority of Nebraska newspapers and has proof of ability to provide a monthly nondigital publication to schools and homes.

Grants shall be used to create and distribute such publication.

The purpose of the publication is to positively impact K-12 reading scores and literacy rate and also to improve lifelong learning skills.

The Legislature shall appropriate one million one hundred seventy thousand dollars form the General Fund for fiscal year

2023-24 and shall appropriate one million one hundred seventy thousand dollars from the General Fund for fiscal year 2024-25 to the State Department of Education to administer such grants.
