Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Summary:

This bill would direct the Nebraska State Historical Society to take action in relation to two historical sites. First, it would be directed to "purchase, update, and manage" the Mayhew Cabin site in Nebraska City. Second, it would be directed to "upgrade and maintain" the Fort Robinson historical site located in Crawford. This bill would also appropriate \$35 million from an as yet undetermined state fund for these uses, as well as for the Standing Bear Museum.
