**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB548 removes the numerical standard of 75 for the jurisprudence of pharmacy examination and instead allows the Board of Pharmacy to set the minimum passing score.

LB548 would require any person authorized to compound to be in compliance with the standards of chapters 795 and 797 of The United States Pharmacopeia and The National Formulary, as such chapters existed on January 1, 2023.
