## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would eliminate the Nebraska Tourism Commission as an independent commission and would reestablish it as an internal component of the Department of Economic Development

## Explanation of amendments:

## AM 688 to LB 624

The committee amendment strikes the original sections. Instead of eliminating the Tourism Commission as an independent agency, it proposes changing the composition of the Commission membership. Such changes would include the addition of a Department of Economic Development seat on the commission as well as a seat for representation from a state chamber of commerce.
