Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 814, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor, is a part of the Governor's biennial budget recommendations. This bill is the mainline appropriations bill for the biennium that begins July 1, 2023 and ends on June 30, 2025. This measure includes the budget recommendations for all State operations and aid programs. The bill includes the appropriate transfers from cash funds to the General Fund, as well as between specified cash funds. Finally, it provides the necessary definitions for the proper administration of appropriations and personal service limitations. This legislative bill contains the emergency clause and becomes operative on July 1, 2023.

Explanation of amendments:

The amendment, AM915, becomes the bill. The amendment contains the Appropriations Committee's recommendation for the bulk of appropriations to be made during the budget biennium for state operations and state aid. Statutorily authorized transfers among funds are made in conformance with budget requirements as are transfers from the General Fund. Please refer to "State of Nebraska FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 Biennial Budget, As Proposed by the Appropriations Committee 108th Legislature, First Session" published May, 2023. Significant increases and reductions from the current year are listed on page 22. A narrative description of highlights of the recommendation begins on page 24 for state aid, followed by operations beginning on page 30. Tabular data follows in additional sections, itemizing the recommendation by agency, aid program, and all fund sources. A narrative description of the recommendation by each state agency begins on page 82. The committee amendment incorporates the provisions of LB 817, which is the appropriations bill for capital construction projects, and provisions of several other bills.
