Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would designate an official state tartan for Nebraska. The tartan would be the one registered with the Scottish Register of Tartans and recognized by governor's proclamation in 2022. A tartan is a distinctive, patterned cloth historically associated with Scottish culture. Since the rise of the Pan-Celtic movement in the Nineteenth Century, tartans have also been associated with other Celtic cultures, including those of Brittany, Cornwall, Ireland, the Isle of Man, and Wales.
